A 19TH CENTURY EBONISED AND GILT BRASS MOUNTED MUSICAL QUARTER CHIMING BRACKET / TABLE CLOCK the case with a flaming finial on a pad top flanked by four further finials, on a plinth base, the sides with Renaissance style gilt pierced frets, the canted front angles with female terms, the break-arch silvered dial with engraved foliate quadrants, Roman numerals and a strike / silent dial to the arch, the associated movement chiming the quarters on a nest of eight graduated bells and the striking the hours on a coiled gong, with pendulum, 69cm high

The case is correctly in good condition with just minor scuffs and marks to the ebonised surface commensurate with age.
