Comprising a carved and pierced mother-of-pearl shell pendant in the shape of an eight-pointed star followed by another five-pointed star in the center, with a suspension ring at the top, mounted and framed, 4cm diam.; and a larger drop-shaped mother-of-pearl shell pendant carved with the theme of *Jesus Entering Jerusalem*, mounted on a red velvet pad on a metal stand, 9cm x 6cm excluding the stand.
