Opaque pigments and ink heightened with gold on paper, comprising two loose illustrated folios each one enhanced with Shaivite iconography, in the first Shiva with his consort, Parvati seated on a tiger skin that's lying on a lotus throne, the recto with 6ll. of black ink *Devanagari* script, 8cm x 14.6cm; the second a depiction of *Sadashiva*, the Supreme Being, a five-headed form of the God, 17.4cm x 11.6cm.
