Adam was a renowned British Filmmaker and BBC producer, writer, art specialist and collector of Modern Art. He wrote *Eileen Gray: Her Life and Work: The Biography* (2009); *Outlines: David Hockney* (1997) and *Art of the Third Reich* (1997).

This work is one of Vaughan's early war-time sketchbook studies. They represent his comrades in the non-combatant No 9 Company, in which he was serving as a contentious objector.
