Persian manuscript on paper, 131ff. plus one fly leaf, each folio with 14ll. of fine black ink *nasta'liq* script arranged in two parallel columns, the opening bifolio now missing, the text on gold-sprinkled ground, chapter headings in gold, catchwords, within gold and blue rules, the opening bifolio of the *Rubaiyat* of Halati section with gold and polychrome illumination, the text in finely illuminated cloudbands, inscribed '*Norman Sowers (?) 104 Squadron, R.A.F., Egypt, 1942*', in marbled paper end papers, set in a later Ottoman dark brown embossed flapped binding, the text panel 12cm x 5cm, the folio 17.7cm x 9.5cm.
